America's hotels know that the commitment to sustainability doesn't end on property. That's why the hotel industry is committed to responsible sourcing to promote the reduction of environmental and social impact at every level of the supply chain.

GREEN LODGING TRENDS

An emerging practice that is implemented by around half of all hotels is purchasing at least 50% of their food and beverage items from fair trade sources.

Nearly all hotels (99.1%) are taking action to source at least one type of produce/product sustainably.

46.5% of hotels purchase at least half of their food and beverage items from fair trade sources (by spend).
